There is a fun and exciting opportunity again this summer available to parents and children! In our third year, **Camp Woodside** is a **Summer Food Service Program** at Woodside Elementary School started by the Greater Austintown Ministerial Association (GAMA) and directed by Lampstand Fellowship.

Camp Woodside this year will be at a new time from 9:30-11:30 a.m. Monday-Friday starting Monday, June 13th until Friday, July 29th for all students who have completed kindergarten to sixth grade. A different Austintown church will be partnering with the program staff of Lampstand each week to provide fun enrichment activities and serve a free lunch to your children.

Our new theme this year is entitled “**Journey Around the World**” where we will travel each week to new regions of the world. We will also be adding a community **Container Garden** where kids will learn important life skills, a **Lunchtime Artist Series** of local guest artists young and old, four **age appropriate groups** and much more!

We assure you that this will be both a fun and safe environment for your kids and is inter-denominational in nature. The lunches will be provided through Neighborhood Ministries in Youngstown and paid for through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and overseen by the Ohio Department of Education (ODE). Lunch is available for any child 1-18 years old regardless of participation of Camp Woodside. *Note: The enrichment program of Camp Woodside is specifically for students who have completed kindergarten to sixth grade.*

The cost to you is absolutely free. We only ask that you promptly drop off your school-aged children at 9:30 a.m. and pick them up at 11:30 a.m. at Woodside Elementary on Elmwood Avenue.
